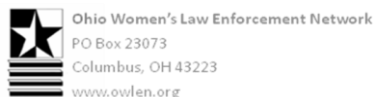
### Cyber Crimes Investigations

Ohio Women's Law Enforcement Network (OWLEN) is proud to present the 2012 Winter Conference on January 25, 2012. This one-day conference will feature presentations from Special Agent Rob White (Federal Bureau of Investigation), Justin Root, Esq. (Porter, Wright, Morris & Arthur, LLP), and agents of the FBI Cyber Crimes Task Force.

The overall purpose of this course is to provide officers and investigators the tools and resources necessary to effectively investigate crimes involving the internet. Training topics include an introduction to cyber crimes, internet research, social networking, cyber-bullying, child pornography, how to work with in-house attorneys, and civil considerations in investigating cyber crimes. Guest speakers will also present recent case studies, including the OSU bomb threat (2011) and crimes involving the website Craigslist.org.

The Ohio State Highway Patrol Academy is located at 740 East 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Columbus, OH 43211. The cost of this training is only \$15 per attendee (which **includes** lunch at the academy). #### **Rob White, Supervisory Special Agent**

*Federal Bureau of Investigation*

SSA White is the supervisor for the FBI Cincinnati's Cyber and Technical Services Squad. He oversees all cyber and technical operations for the FBI in Central and Southern Ohio, manages three cyber task forces, and leads approximately 25 agents and task force officers in the daily investigation of computer intrusions, cyber terrorism, Internet extortion and child pornography/exploitation matters.

#### **Detective Brett Peachey**

*Westerville Police & FBI Task Force Officer*

Det. Peachey is a member of the Westerville Police Department's Internet Crimes Enforcement (ICE) team. He has been a guest speaker in numerous presentations to both students and parents regarding Internet safety and the dangers of social networking. In 2010, Det. Peachey received the "Distinguished Achievement Award" from the Ohio Attorney General's Office for his work with the Franklin County Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force.

#### **Justin Root, Esq.**

*Porter, Wright, Morris & Arthur, LLP*

Justin graduated *magna cum laude* from Capital University in 2008 and has worked at Porter, Wright, Morris & Arthur, LLP since. Justin's law practice focuses on general commercial litigation, information privacy, and data security. Justin previously worked as an investigator for The Ohio State University Police Division specializing in computer and white collar crimes. He spent two years with the FBI's Cyber Crimes Task Force and was commissioned as a Special Deputy United States Marshall.
